What is the “New” Double Lunch Ministry?

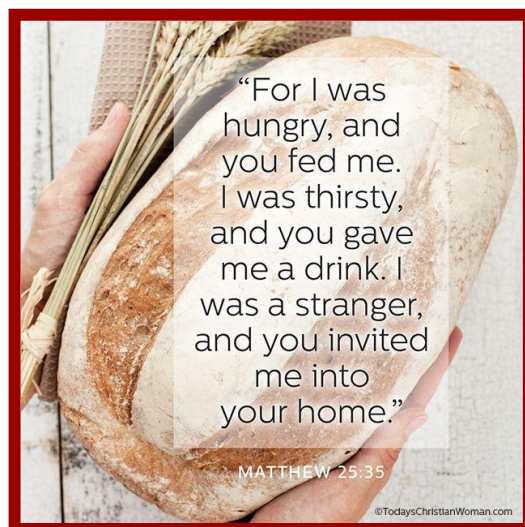

What to donate?

Please consider a donation of granola bars, breakfast bars, individual packaged chips, apple sauces, etc. Napkins and plastic utensils are also a great donation! (Please, no beverage collection at this time).

How to safely donate?

- Each Wednesday morning, there will be totes to collect supplies at the drop off area of school.
- Please have donations out and ready to drop off (not in child’s backpack)!
- Have your child carry and place the donation in the tote on their way into school. Donations should not be taken into the school, rather left in the totes on the outside of school.
- HASA will send one of their wonderful volunteers to the drop off area (after drop off is over) to pick up the donations for delivery!
