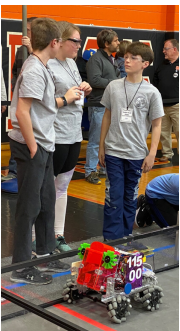

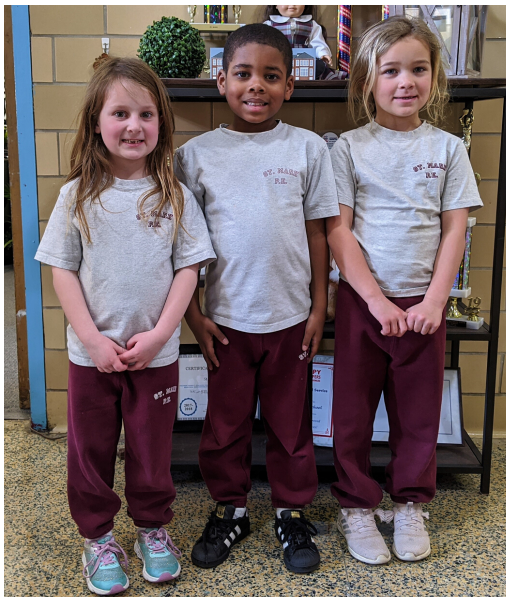


## PBIS Spotlights
